Abstract: Kitchens are pervasive spaces which have evolved over the years with respect to its structure, positionality and soci practices. It has transformed from being stationed at the corner of the house to now being the heart of the home. Human interaction with the kitchen are evolving specifically in terms of gendered performances. In India, according to the socio-cultural more domestic kitchen spaces have been a feminine sphere where women spend most of their time cooking, organising and cleanin These spaces have now been positioned in the dichotomy of resentment and rejuvenation. On the one hand, they are a marker of women's entrapment, on the other, the kitchen offers self-awareness, freedom and a sense of belonging. However, there has been a gradual shift in perspective. In this study, I problematise the dualities of the kitchen space and analyse the changing gendered dynamics in the Indian context in the face of massive technological intervention and changes in economic, political and soci structures. I employ textual analysis to make sense of the changing gendered dynamics within the kitchen space through popul media texts like films, advertisements and YouTube videos.
